Resolution # C-4

<u>IEB REPRESENTATION</u> TO MAINTAIN EXISTING AREA REPRESENTATION

The International Executive Board recommends that Article VI, Section 2 of the International Constitution be modified to maintain the existing area representation on the International Executive Board. The revised section will read:

The allocation of Executive Board members in the areas shall be in the following manner: for the first 1,000 members or less, one Executive Board member; over 1,000 and up to 3,000 members, two Executive Board members; over 3,000 and up to 10,000 members, three Executive Board members; over 10,000 and up to 14,000, four Executive Board members. Any area with more than 14,000 members shall be entitled to a maximum of five Executive Board members. Any local with more than 14,000 members shall be entitled to one ex-officio member of the Executive Board.
